Sutton Council publishes 'feasibility studies' on two potential sites for new secondary school

The Greenshaw Learning Trust's application to the Department for the Education (DfE) to establish a new secondary school in Sutton for September 2017 received approval in March to move to the 'preopening' phase. The Greenshaw Learning Trust is currently in discussions with the DfE about taking the proposals forward.

The site for the new school is still to be determined - this is a matter for the Department for Education and will be subject to their assessment of the feasibility of possible sites and to the full planning process.

Sutton Council has identified two possible locations for the school - at the Sutton Hospital site and at the disused all weather pitch at Rosehill. The Council has carried out its own 'feasibility studies' into these sites, which it has published on its website and made available to the Greenshaw Learning Trust and the DfE.
